# 1. Deliverable Objective

This deliverable consists of providing an initial version of the Khresmoi website<sup>1</sup>.

The web site should contain a section with a list of publications and also press releases and articles in the popular press. A list of the first press releases should be given in the deliverable. All public deliverables will be available as PDF files from the web page. The web site should also include an RSS feeder with news on the project that will be updated regularly.

# 2. Description of the architecture

A first information exchange was performed between all partners to get an overview of the different CMSs (Content Management System) available and being used, resulting in Joomla, Drupal and Silverstripe. After a comparison of the three tools, Silverstripe was considered easier to implement and use. The two other tools may have more options but Silverstripe covers those important for the project.

Therefore the solution for the public KHRESMOI website consists of the Silverstripe CMS coupled with a MySql database.

The main reasons for the choice of Silverstripe were the following:

- intuitive user interface;
- easily extendable;
- · large number of additional modules;
- helpful tutorials available;
- active user community;
- open source;
- · free of charge.

The CMS itself is written in PHP running on an Apache web server. For the operating system the decision was in favor of Suse Linux Enterprise Server 10 SP3, which was installed on a virtual machine hosted by the IT Service of the HES-SO in Sierre, Switzerland.
